¹The Very Hungry Caterpillar story begins with a little egg lay on a leaf under the moonlight on one Saturday morning. ²The next morning(Sunday), when the warm sun came up, the little egg popped out a small and very hungry caterpillar.

³The caterpillar started to look for some food over the course of the week. He found several kinds of fruit to eat and made holes through the food that he liked. ⁴On Monday, he ate through an apple, but he was still hungry. ⁵On Tuesday, he ate through two pears, but he was still hungry. ⁶On Wednesday he ate three plums, but he was still hungry. ⁷On Thursday, he ate four strawberries, but he was still hungry. ⁸On Friday he ate five oranges, but he was still hungry.

⁹On Saturday he ate holes through a bunch of human food, including 1 piece of chocolate cake, ¹⁰1 ice cream cone, ¹¹1 pickle, ¹²1 slice of swiss cheese, ¹³1 slice of salami, ¹⁴1 lollipop, ¹⁵1 piece of cherry pie, ¹⁶1 sausage, ¹⁷1 cupcake and ¹⁸1 slice of watermelon. That night, all this food gave him a stomachache. ¹⁹Fortunately, he only ate a cleansing green leaf on Sunday, which made him started to feel better.

²⁰Now, the caterpillar was no longer small and hungry, he was a big and fat caterpillar. ²¹He builds a cocoon around himself and stayed inside for more than 2 weeks. Then, he nibbled a small hole in the cocoon, pushed his way out ²²and showed himself to be a beautiful butterfly.
