## 內容簡介:

<sup>1</sup>The Very Hungry Caterpillar story begins with a little egg lay on a leaf under the moonlight on one Saturday morning. <sup>2</sup>The next morning(Sunday), when the warm sun came up, the little egg popped out a small and very hungry caterpillar.

<sup>3</sup>The caterpillar started to look for some food over the course of the week. He found several kinds of fruit to eat and made holes through the food that he liked. <sup>4</sup>On Monday, he ate through an apple, but he was still hungry. <sup>5</sup>On Tuesday, he ate through two pears, but he was still hungry. <sup>6</sup>On Wednesday he ate three plums, but he was still hungry. <sup>7</sup>On Thursday, he ate four strawberries, but he was still hungry. <sup>8</sup>On Friday he ate five oranges, but he was still hungry.

<sup>9</sup>On Saturday he ate holes through a bunch of human food, including 1 piece of chocolate cake, <sup>10</sup>1 ice cream cone, <sup>11</sup>1 pickle, <sup>12</sup>1 slice of swiss cheese, <sup>13</sup>1 slice of salami, <sup>14</sup>1 lollipop, <sup>15</sup>1 piece of cherry pie, <sup>16</sup>1 sausage, <sup>17</sup>1 cupcake and <sup>18</sup>1 slice of watermelon. That night, all this food gave him a stomachache. <sup>19</sup>Fortunately, he only ate a cleansing green leaf on Sunday, which made him started to feel better.

<sup>20</sup>Now, the caterpillar was no longer small and hungry, he was a big and fat caterpillar. <sup>21</sup>He builds a cocoon around himself and stayed inside for more than 2 weeks. Then, he nibbled a small hole in the cocoon, pushed his way out <sup>22</sup>and showed himself to be a beautiful butterfly.
